**RESOLUTION NO. 130, S-2022**

**SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS LOTS THAT WILL SERVE AS MUNICIPAL PUBLIC CEMETERIES FOR THE THREE DISTRICTS OF LINGAYEN.**

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan is in receipt of a letter from the Municipal Mayor seeking support to his intention of putting up three (3) Municipal Cemeteries to cater to the Central, Western and Southern Barangays of Lingayen;

WHEREAS, the old Municipal Cemetery located at Barangay Maniboc is already congested due to space limitation, hence, the need to transfer the bones/remains of those entombed/buried in the said burial site to the new Municipal Ossuary to give way for its rehabilitation and development thus necessitating the purchase of lots for new cemetery while rehab works are ongoing;

WHEREAS, there is need for the municipality to venture into land banking for this purpose and for other future use;

WHEREAS, the funds necessary in the negotiation and acquisition of lots shall be taken from any available funds of the Municipal Government of Lingayen;

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body fully supports the plan of the Municipal Mayor and collectively agrees to authorize him to pursue his intent of acquiring lots for the three (3) public cemeteries and to sign documents to effect said purpose;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Rodolfo Luigi F. Morosi, duly seconded by SBM Jonathan T. Ramos, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to support and to authorize the Municipal Mayor to negotiate for the acquisition of various lots that will serve as Municipal Public Cemeteries for the three districts of Lingayen.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Municipal Mayor for his information and guidance.

Dear **Vice Mayor Malicdem**:

With Undas 2022 came the realization that we need to provide a more accessible, respectable, and orderly resting place for our town's dearly departed. At present, the public cemeteries in Lingayen are overcrowded, disorganized, and inconvenient. To solve this problem, the undersigned respectfully requests your good office **for the support of the Sangguniang Bayan** in the immediate passage of an Ordinance and/or Resolution **establishing and regulating the use of three (3) public cemeteries in Lingayen: the first will cater to the central barangays, the second to the western barangays and the third to the southern barangays.** In line with this, the old cemetery in Barangay Maniboc will have to be closed for rehabilitation and development, and the remains of the departed would have to be solemnly placed in an ossuary to be built for the said purpose. As such, funds will need to be allocated for the acquisition of the necessary lots, development, maintenance and regulation of the proposed memorial parks. Hopefully, with these projects, we are able to make our constituents feel that public service should not be limited to the living, but should extend to those who have gone before.

The said projects are certified urgent, necessary, and of utmost priority.
