RESOLUTION NO. 140, S-2022

AUTHORIZING MAYOR LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CENTER FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT – I (DOH CHD-I) FOR THE GRANT OF HEALTH EMERGENCY ALLOWANCE (HEA) TO ELIGIBLE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HEALTH CARE WORKERS AND NON-HEALTH WORKERS.

WHEREAS, presented for consideration of the Sangguniang Bayan was the letter of Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil dated November 15, 2022 requesting for an authority to enter into an agreement with the Department of Health Center for Health Development I (DOHCHD-I) for the grant of Health Emergency Allowance (HEA) to eligible public and private health care workers and non-health care workers;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11712 known as the Public Health Emergency Benefits and Allowances for Health Care Workers Act provides for the payment of Health Emergency Allowance (HEA), Sickness and Death Compensation and other benefits for public and private health workers (HCWs) and non-HCWs during the COVID-19 pandemic and other future public health emergencies with retroactive application starting July 1, 2021;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the same Act stipulates that the amount of HEA shall vary based on the risk exposure categorization of the HCWs and non-HCWs in particular setting: Three Thousand Pesos (₱3,000.00) for low risk, Six Thousand Pesos (₱6,000.00) for medium risk, and Nine Thousand Pesos (₱9,000.00) for high risk;

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2022, DOH issued Administrative Order No. 2022-0001 setting the guidelines for COVID-19 Risk Exposure Classification of Health Care Workers, as amended, to determine the risk exposure of personnel in COVID-19 response-involved health facilities; and on September 2, 2022 it again issued AO No. 2022-0039 to provide supplemental guidelines on the grant of HEA pursuant to RA No 11712 and its IRR;

WHEREAS, the local government unit of Lingayen understands and recognizes the selflessness and immense sacrifice of the health workers who catered to COVID-19 patients, persons under investigation (PUIs) and persons under monitoring (PUMs) during the pandemic;

WHEREAS, the authority to be given to the Municipal Mayor is necessary to facilitate the payment of HEA benefits to eligible HCWs and non-HCWs as guided by DOH AO No. 2022-0039 and DOH AO No. 2022-0001, as amended;

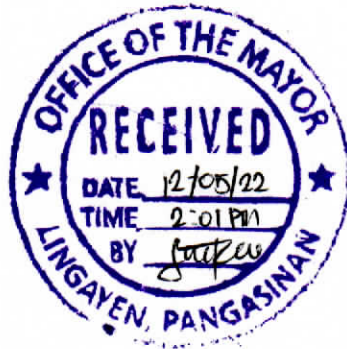
WHEREAS, after careful perusal of the submitted draft Memorandum of Agreement, it was found to be in order;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Von Carlo E. Tiangson, duly seconded by all members present, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to authorize Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Health Center for Health Development-I (DOH CHD-I) for the grant of Health Emergency Allowance (HEA) to eligible Public and Private Health Care Workers and Non-Health Care Workers.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil and Director Paula Paz M. Sydiongco, MD, MPH, MBA, CESO IV of DOH-CHD-I for their information and guidance.
