CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS

This *Contract Agreement* is entered into this **JUN 15 2021** in Lingayen, Pangasinan, by and between:

THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, a local government unit duly created and existing under Philippine Law, represented by **HON. LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, in his capacity as Municipal Mayor, herein referred to as **The Procuring Entity**;

--- and ---

RENSIS TRADING, a sole proprietorship duly registered with the Department of Trade and Industry, with principal place of business at 212 Malabago, Calasiao, Pangasinan, represented herein by its owner, **KAREN S. RAMOS**, of legal age, married, Filipino Citizen, and resident of 212 Malabago Calasiao, Pangasinan, herein referred to as *The Supplier*,

WHEREAS, *the Procuring Entity* invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly the *Procurement of COVID-19 Antigen test and Kits at GSO, Lingayen, Pangasinan* and has accepted Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of *Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Pesos and Seventy Centavos Only (P530,999.70)*, Philippine Currency (hereinafter called the Contract Price).

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the *2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184* shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Purchase Request
 - b. Request Of Quotation
 - c. Resolution of Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's *conforme* thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents that may be required by the existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**
3. In consideration for the sum of *Five Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Pesos Only (P531,000.00)*, the Supplier agrees to supply the *COVID-19 Antigen test and Kits at GSO, Lingayen, Pangasinan* in accordance with his Bid.
4. The Procuring Entity agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
5. The Supplier hereby agrees to refund the Procuring Entity the amount considered to be overpriced as declared by the Commission on Audit (COA).
6. In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected, the Supplier shall provide a warranty security for a period of three (3) months, in the case of Expandable Supplies, or a period of one (1) year, in case of Non-expandable Supplies, counted from the acceptance by the Procuring Entity of the delivered supplies.
7. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by retention money in an amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period or, in the case of Expandable Supplies, after consumption thereof: Provided, however, That the supplies delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.
8. The procuring Entity reserves the right to reject the goods despite acceptance by the General Services Office or the End User in case the goods fail to meet technical Specifications.
9. Any and all the disputes arising from the implementation of this Contract Agreement shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provision of R.A. 876, otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law" and R.A. 9285, otherwise known as the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004."
10. In case of breach of contract, the Supplier shall be liable for liquidated damages equal to one-tenth of one percent (0.001) of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

all claims of immunity from jurisdiction and any objection which such Party may now or hereafter have to the laying of venue of any suit, action or Proceeding in any designed court, including any right to object on the basis that any dispute, action, suit or proceeding brought in the Designated Courts has been brought in an improper or inconvenient forum or venue.
