**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04, Series of 2023**  
**AN ORDER RE-ORGANIZING MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL AND ITS SPECIAL ACTION COMMITTEES**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 gives Local Government Units (LGUs) the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for the maintenance of peace and order and the preservation of the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 773 dated January 5, 2009 issued by Former President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo mandates the reorganization of Peace and Order Councils at the National, Regional, Provincial, City and Municipal levels of government;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update the composition of the Municipal Peace and Order Council due to the 2022 National and Local Elections, changes of NGA and LGU personnel and the re/accreditation of Civil Society Organizations;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL, Municipal Mayor of Lingayen, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the Municipal Peace and Order Council of this municipality, as follows:

**Section 1.** The composition of the Municipal Peace and Order Council shall be reorganized and composed of the following:

**Section 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS:** The Municipal Peace and Order Council shall perform the following functions:

1. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberations of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
2. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including anti-insurgency measures;
3. Initiate and/or oversee the convergence and the orchestration of internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
4. Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against municipal/Barangay executives who are giving material and political support to the communist rebels;
5. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them from the communist rebels' "Agitate/Arouse; Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organizational works;
6. Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or the NPOC.





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The Civilian Volunteer Organizations (CVOs) shall be managed and supervised by the PNP Chief of Police.

**Section 3. SPECIAL ACTION COMMITTEES (SAC).** The Special Action Committees and its composition are hereby organized. These are:

**3.1 SAC on ANTI-CRIMINALITY**

#### 3.4.2 FUNCTIONS

- Establish Special Operation Procedures during peace and order and public safety emergencies, and other critical situations;
- Respond to related emergency and critical situations in close coordination with the MPOC;
- Perform such other related tasks as may be directed by competent authorities.

**Section 4: PEACE AND ORDER SECRETARIAT**- There shall be a Peace and Order Council Secretariat which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the Peace and Order Council that is organized in the various administrative levels of government. The Secretariat shall also undertake liasoning and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government.

The **Municipal Local Government Operations Officer** shall head the **MPOC Secretariat** and shall be assisted by its staffs. Staffs of the Council Chairman will provide necessary assistance when needed.





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**Section 5. MEETING-** The Council shall meet on a quarterly basis or as often as necessary.

**Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE-** All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the Peace and Order Council inconsistent herewith shall be deemed superseded by this order.

**Section 7. EFFECTIVITY-** This order shall take effect immediately.
