EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12, S-2022

**IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY
OF LINGAYEN UNDER ALERT LEVEL 1**

WHEREAS, Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution No. 163-A dated February 27, 2022, placed the province of Pangasinan under Alert Level 2 from March 1 to 15, 2022.

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, I, **LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order as follows:

Minimum Public Health Standards

Section 1. Wearing of face mask, washing of hands, and maintaining physical distancing shall be implemented at all times.

Section 2. Well-fitted masks shall be worn properly at all times, whether outdoors or in indoor private or public establishments, including in public transportation by land, air, or sea, except for the following instances:

- a) Eating and drinking;
- b) Participating in team and individual sports in venues where ventilation standards can be maintained;
- c) Practicing outdoor sports/exercise activities where physical distance can be maintained.

Government and Private Establishments

Section 3. Agencies and instrumentalities of the government shall adhere to 100% on-site workforce. Off-site work shall be under such work arrangements subject to relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission and the Office of the President.

Section 4. All private offices and workplaces, including public and private construction sites, may operate at full 100% capacity (consistent with national issuances on vaccination requirements for on-site work). However, they may continue to provide flexible and alternative work arrangements as deemed appropriate based on function or individual risk.





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Section 5. Only hotels or accommodation establishments with valid DOT Accreditation shall be allowed to accommodate guests and clients subject to guidelines issued by the Department of Tourism and the IATF.

Section 6. Government and private establishments shall regularly disinfect high-risk areas such as but not limited to areas for gatherings, highly touched surfaces, and frequently visited areas such as entrance and exit points, restrooms, hallways, elevators using Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-approved disinfectants.

Section 7. The use of foot baths, disinfection tents, misting chambers, or sanitation booths for preventing and controlling COVID-19 transmission are not recommended.

Section 8. Temperature checking prior to the entry in any establishment may be dispensed with.

Section 9. The use of plastic/acrylic barriers/dividers are optional, as appropriate.

Section 10. Use of health declaration forms / paper-based contact tracing shall not be required for all the agencies and establishments.

Section 11. Use of digital contact tracing such as the StaySafe.PH application is optional for all the agencies and establishments.

Section 12. Establishments are no longer required to set-up isolation facilities within the workplace.

Proof of Full Vaccination

Section 13. Individuals eighteen (18) years old and above will be required to present proof of full vaccination before participating in mass gatherings or entry into indoor establishments listed below. Children ages seventeen (17) and below shall not be required to present proof of full vaccination status.

- a) In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 and for the cremains of the COVID-19 deceased;
- b) All indoor dine-in services of food preparation establishments such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries. For outdoor or al fresco dining and take out channels, no proof of full vaccination is required;
- c) All indoor personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, hair salons, and nail spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, salons, spas, reflexology, and other similar procedures including home service options;





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- d) Fitness studios, gyms, and venues for exercise and contact and non-contact sports;
- e) Cinemas and movie houses;
- f) Meetings, incentives, conferences, exhibition events, and permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers;
- g) Venues with live voice or wind-instrument performers and audiences such as in karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, and theaters;
- h) Indoor ancillary establishments in hotels and other accommodation establishments;
- i) Film, music, and television production;
- j) Visitor or tourist attractions such as libraries, archives, museums, galleries, exhibits, parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks, and the like;
- k) Amusement parks and theme parks;
- l) Recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiard halls, amusement arcades, bowling alleys, skating rinks, archery halls, swimming pools, and similar venues;
- m) Funfairs/peryas and kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playrooms, and kiddie rides; and
- n) Venues for election-related events.

Movement of Goods and Cargoes

Section 14. The movement by land, air, or sea of all types of goods and cargoes—including their personnel and delivery vehicles—to and from their destination regardless of alert level, shall remain unhampered

Public Transportation

Section 15. Public transportation shall be at full seating capacity. For intrazonal and inter-zonal travels involving public land transportation between an area with a higher alert level classification, the passenger capacity shall be that which has the lower passenger capacity rate between the point of origin and point of destination.

Section 16. For aviation and maritime transport operating in and out of the Municipality of Lingayen, the passenger capacity will be at 100%.





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Section 17. The use of acrylic and/or plastic dividers shall not be required.

Section 18. The use of the Safe, Swift and Smart Passage (S-PaSS) travel management system shall likewise not be required for interzonal travel to the Municipality of Lingayen.

The Lingayen Public Market and Municipal Slaughterhouse

Section 19. The Lingayen Public Market and Municipal Slaughterhouse shall be open seven days a week. Vendors at the public market are enjoined to maintain cleanliness in their stalls and their surroundings.

Lifting of Liquor Ban

Section 20. The modified liquor ban is now lifted.

Curfew

Section 21. There shall be a curfew from 12:00 midnight to 4:00 in the morning.


Penal Clause

Section 22. Any violation of these Guidelines may be prosecuted under the appropriate local ordinance or as non-cooperation of the person or entities punishable under Section 9 par. (d) or (e), as the case may be, of Republic Act No. 11332, otherwise known as the *Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act*, and its *Implementing Rules and Regulations*.

Effectivity

Section 23. This Executive Order shall take effect on March 1, 2022, and shall remain in force unless modified or repealed as circumstances warrant.
