EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 02, S-2022

**IMPLEMENTING PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST
THE THREAT OF THE COVID-19 OMICRON VARIANT**

WHEREAS, while the national IATF-EID has retained the classification of the Province of Pangasinan under Alert Level 2, the National Capital Region and various parts of the country were placed under the stricter Alert Level 3 in view of the exponential increase in COVID-19 cases in their respective territorial jurisdictions.

WHEREAS, the Provincial Governor issued Executive Order No. 0001-2022 to preemptively escalate measures in Pangasinan against the threat of the Omicron variant.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL, Municipal Mayor of Lingayen, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order as follows:

Curfew

Section 1. A municipality-wide curfew shall be observed from 9:00 in the evening to 4:00 in the morning. Violations thereof shall be subject to prosecution under existing provincial and municipal ordinances.

Limited Movement of Unvaccinated Persons

Section 2. Unvaccinated individuals or individuals with incomplete vaccinations are strongly advised to stay at home, except for emergency or humanitarian reasons.

Section 3. Unvaccinated individuals, especially children below 12 years old, shall not be allowed entry to enclosed establishments, including, but not limited to malls, supermarkets, and restaurants.

Limitation on Mass Gatherings

Section 4. The conduct of events that tend to cause mass gathering, such as, but not limited to fiesta celebrations, activities of the *Sangguniang Kabataan*, community dances, and basketball tournaments, are not allowed.

Section 5. Fairs/*peryas* are to strictly observe their respective operational capacity at a maximum of 50% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals, and 70% outdoor venue capacity, provided that all workers/employees of these establishments are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and minimum public health standards are strictly maintained:

Section 6. Casinos, horse racing, cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments shall not be allowed to operate, or be undertaken except as may be authorized by the IATF or the Office of the President.

Section 7. Mass gathering activities should avoid catering to those with comorbidities and pregnant women, and those unvaccinated persons especially children below 12 years old.

Public Transportation

Section 8. Public transport operators are directed to observe 70% maximum passenger capacity.

Section 9. Emphasis is made on the strict implementation of minimum public health standards of passengers, drivers, and conductors in public transportation vehicles, such as, but not limited to:

- A. Wearing of face masks at all times;
- B. No unnecessary talking and making of phone calls;
- C. No eating while in transit;
- D. Keeping PUVs well-ventilated;
- E. Conduct of frequent disinfection;
- F. No passengers with COVID-19 symptoms are to be allowed inside any public transportation vehicle;
- G. Observance of appropriate physical distancing.

Market and Slaughterhouse

Section 10. The *baratillo* and food park established on the roof deck of the Agri-Aqua Market Building shall operate until January 09, 2022.

Section 11. Starting January 17, 2022, the Lingayen Public Market and Municipal Slaughterhouse shall be closed on Mondays for clean-up and sanitation. *Talipapas* situated in different barangays are also encouraged to observe a market holiday every Monday.

Vaccination Drives

Section 12. Rural Health Units 1, 2, and 3 are directed to continue their vaccination drives, with full implementation of measures to avoid mass gatherings and maintain physical distancing.

Effectivity

Section 13. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
