**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22, SERIES OF 2022**

**REQUIRING WATER REFILLING STATIONS  
TO OBTAIN BUSINESS OR MAYOR'S PERMIT  
BEFORE COMMENCING OPERATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, contaminated water and poor sanitation are linked to transmission of diseases such as cholera, diarrhea, dysentery, hepatitis A, typhoid and polio. Absent, inadequate, or inappropriately managed water and sanitation services expose individuals to preventable health risks.

**WHEREAS**, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and public health.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order as follows:

**Section 1.** All water refilling stations in the Municipality of Lingayen are required to obtain the necessary Business or Mayor's Permit before commencing operations.

**Section 2.** The delivery persons of water refilling stations, whether from within or outside Lingayen, are required to carry with them copies of a valid Business or Mayor's Permit from the local government unit which has jurisdiction over their principal place of business.

**Section 3.** Barangay tanods and the Philippine National Police are directed to do random checking of deliveries of drinking water to ensure that the operator has a valid Business or Mayor's Permit. In the absence of a Business or Mayor's Permit, the barangay tanods and the Philippine National Police shall direct the person concerned to obtain a Business or Mayor's Permit before completing the delivery.
