EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35, SERIES OF 2022

SUSPENDING CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AS WELL AS WORK IN THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code, every local government unit shall exercise powers which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare within their respective territorial jurisdictions and shall ensure and support the promotion of health and safety;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Executive Order No. 66, Series of 2012, issued by then President Benigno Aquino III provides that classes in all levels in both public and private schools as well as work in the government offices may be cancelled or suspended in areas affected by disasters or calamities other than typhoons, such as but not limited to floods, earthquakes, tsunami and conflagration;

WHEREAS, at about 8:43 in the morning today, a magnitude 7 earthquake was felt in Northern Luzon which brought back memories of the devastating 1990 Luzon earthquake;

WHEREAS, several aftershocks may occur at any moment which could place lives in peril;

WHEREAS, there is also a need to inspect the integrity of the buildings in Lingayen;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, **I, LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, hereby order the suspension of classes in all levels in both public and private schools as well as work in the municipal government for the rest of the day from 1:00 PM, except for the frontline offices of the Bureau of Fire Protection, Municipal Engineering Office, Rural Health Units, LDRRMC, and Philippine National Police.

The suspension of work in other government offices and private establishment shall be under the discretion of the head of said office or establishment.

Furthermore, the Municipal Engineering Office, Bureau of Fire Protection, BDRRMO, LDRRMO, and utilities providers Prime Water and CENPELCO are ordered to inspect public buildings, school buildings, private establishments, and water and electric lines to ensure the safety of all concerned.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
