EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04, SERIES OF 2022

IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN UNDER ALERT LEVEL 3

WHEREAS, Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution 156-C placed the province of Pangasinan under Alert Level 3 from January 14 to 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, under the law, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, I, **LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order as follows:

Minimum Public Health Standards

Section 1. Minimum public health standards shall be implemented at all times. Such measures include, but are not limited to wearing face mask, maintaining physical distancing, installation of hygiene stations, and ventilation for enclosed areas.

Section 2. All persons are mandated to wear face masks whenever they go out of their residences, at the workplace, when entering government buildings, and while in public places.

Section 3. The use of face shields shall now be voluntary. However, the use of face shields shall be mandatory in medical, quarantine, and healthcare facility settings.

Limited Movement of Unvaccinated Persons

Section 4. Unvaccinated individuals or individuals with incomplete vaccinations are strongly advised to stay at home, except for emergency or humanitarian reasons.

Section 5. Unvaccinated individuals, especially children below 12 years old, shall not be allowed entry to enclosed establishments, including, but not limited to malls, supermarkets, and restaurants.

Limitation on Mass Gatherings

Section 6. The conduct of events that tend to cause mass gathering, such as, but not limited to fiesta celebrations, activities of the *Sangguniang Kabataan*, community dances, and basketball tournaments, are not allowed.

Section 7. Mass gathering activities should avoid catering to those with comorbidities and pregnant women, and those unvaccinated persons especially children below 12 years old.

Curfew

Section 8. A municipality-wide curfew shall be observed from 9:00 in the evening to 4:00 in the morning.

Operational Capacities of Establishments

Section 9. The following establishments and/or activities characterized as high-risk for transmission shall not be allowed to operate, or be undertaken:

- a. Face to face or in-person classes for basic education, except those previously approved by the IATF and/or the Office of the President;
- b. Contact sports, except those conducted under a bubble-type setup as provided for under relevant guidelines adopted by the IATF, Games and Amusement Board, and Philippine Sports Commission, and approved by the LGU where such games shall be held;
- c. Funfairs/peryas and kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom, and kiddie rides;
- d. Venues with live voice or wind-instrument performers and audiences such as in karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, and theaters;
- e. Casinos, horse racing, cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments except as may be authorized by the IATF or the Office of the President; and

- f. Gatherings in residences with individuals not belonging to the same household.

Section 10. The following establishments or activities shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at a maximum of **30% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals only** and 50% outdoor venue capacity. Provided that all on-site workers/employees of these establishments, and organizers of activities are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and minimum public health standards shall be strictly maintained:

- g. Venues for meetings, incentives, conferences, and exhibitions (MICE);
- h. Permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers;
- i. Visitor or tourist attractions such as libraries, archives, museums, galleries, exhibits, parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks, and the like;
- j. Amusement parks or theme parks;
- k. Recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiard halls, amusement arcades, bowling alleys, skating rinks, archery halls, swimming pools, and similar venues;
- l. Cinemas and movie houses;
- m. Limited face-to-face or in-person classes for higher education and for technical-vocational education and training;
- n. In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 and for the cremains of the COVID-19 deceased;
- o. Licensure or entrance/qualifying examinations administered by their respective government agency, and specialty examinations authorized by the IATF subject to the health and safety guidelines as approved by the IATF;

- p. Dine-in services in food preparation establishments such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries, subject to Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) sector-specific protocols;
- q. Personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, hair salons, and nail spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, salons, spas, reflexology, and other similar procedures including home service options, subject to the sector-specific protocols of the DTI;
- r. Fitness studios, gyms, and venues for individual non-contact exercise and sports; Provided that patrons/clients and workers/employees wear face masks at all times and subject to DTI sector-specific protocols.
- s. Film, music, and television production subject to the joint guidelines as may be issued by the DTI, Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Department of Health (DOH);

Section 11. Establishments permitted to operate may be allowed additional venue/seating capacity on top of the existing allowable venue/seating capacities, as follows:

- t. An additional twenty percent (20%) if the Municipality of Lingayen has reached a vaccination coverage above seventy percent (70%) for both Priority Group A2 (senior citizens) and Priority Group A3 (adults with comorbidities), as determined by the Vaccine Cluster of the National Task Force Against COVID-19; and
- u. An additional ten percent (10%) if said establishments have been awarded Safety Seal Certificates under the Safety Seal Certification Program.

Section 12. Agencies and instrumentalities of the government shall remain to be fully operational and shall adhere to at least 60% on-site workforce. Those assigned to work off-site shall be subject to alternative work arrangements as approved by the head of agency in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission (CSC). Heads of agencies providing health and emergency frontline services, laboratory and testing services, border control, or other critical services shall operate at a workforce beyond the minimum as may be necessary to deliver their mandates.

Section 13. Only hotels or accommodation establishments with valid DOT Accreditation shall be allowed to accommodate guests and clients subject to guidelines issued by the Department of Tourism and the IATF.

Modified Liquor Ban

Section 14. The sale, purchase, distribution, and drinking of alcoholic beverage in the confines of one's own home and in enclosed establishments that provide food and drinks is permitted.

Section 15. The drinking of alcoholic beverage in other public places such as schools, workplaces, government facilities, unenclosed establishments that provide food and drinks, playgrounds, sports ground or centers, church grounds, health/hospital compounds, transportation terminals, markets, parks, resorts, walkways/sideways, entrance ways, waiting areas, and the like is prohibited.

Clean-Up Day

Section 16. The Lingayen Public Market and Municipal Slaughterhouse shall remain closed on Mondays for clean-up and sanitation. *Talipapas* situated in different barangays are also encouraged to observe a market holiday every Monday.

Public Transportation

Section 17. Public transport operators are directed to observe 70% maximum passenger capacity.

Section 18. Emphasis is made on the strict implementation of minimum public health standards of passengers, drivers, and conductors in public transportation vehicles, such as, but not limited to:

- a. Wearing of face masks at all times;
- b. No unnecessary talking and making of phone calls;
- c. No eating while in transit;
- d. Keeping public utility vehicles well-ventilated;
- e. Conduct of frequent disinfection;

- f. No passengers with COVID-19 symptoms are to be allowed inside any public transportation vehicle;
- g. Observance of appropriate physical distancing.

Vaccination Drives

Section 19. Rural Health Units 1, 2, and 3 are directed to continue their vaccination drives, with full implementation of measures to avoid mass gatherings and maintain physical distancing.

Penal Provisions

Section 20. Any violation of the foregoing prohibitions shall be punishable under the appropriate law or ordinance.

Effectivity

Section 21. This Executive Order shall take effect on January 14, 2022, and shall remain in force unless modified or repealed as circumstances warrant.
