**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43-A, SERIES OF 2021**

**SUSPENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF  
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43, SERIES OF 2021**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 5, of the 1987 Constitution recognizes that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy.

WHEREAS, under Article II, Section 15, of the 1987 Constitution, it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers local government units to exercise the powers which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, health, and safety within their respective territorial jurisdictions.

WHEREAS, the undersigned issued Executive Orders Nos. 40,<sup>1</sup> 41,<sup>2</sup> and 42,<sup>3</sup> Series of 2021 to abate the rise of COVID-19 cases in the Municipality.

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2021, Governor Amado I. Espino III issued Letter Circular No. 2021-0159 enjoining LGUs to implement emergency measures to address the recent spikes of COVID-19 cases in Pangasinan.

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2021, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 43 implementing heightened restrictions in the Municipality of Lingayen in anticipation of the National IATF's resolution placing the entire province under heightened General Community Quarantine.

WHEREAS, pending the issuance of a formal Resolution placing the entire Municipality under GCQ, the undersigned deems it wise **to suspend certain provisions of Executive Order No. 43, Series of 2021.**

NOW THEREFORE, I, **LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order the following:

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1. The implementation of paragraph 7 of Executive Order No. 43, Series of 2021, is suspended for the time being. As such, Food preparation establishments such, as but not limited to commissaries, restaurants, eateries, fast food chains, cafes, and the like may operate with their indoor dine-in services at the venue or seating capacity of thirty percent (30%), and with their *al fresco* or outdoor dine-in services at the venue or seating capacity of fifty percent (50%).
2. The implementation of paragraph 10 of Executive Order No. 43, Series of 2021, regarding the market schedule and issuance of quarantine pass is likewise suspended until further notice. However, the public market and slaughterhouse shall remain closed on Mondays for decontamination.
