EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Rule IV, Article 22 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the sanggunian of component cities and municipalities may, in consultation with the National Historical Institute change the name of streets, roads, schools, health facilities or any other public place or building within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the newly constructed Multi-Purpose Hall located at Barangay Rosario, Lingayen, Pangasinan has not been officially named;

WHEREAS, there is a need to name said building for proper identification;

WHEREAS, it is the clamor of the people and the Barangay Council of Rosario to name said edifice to Gabriel D. Tuazon Sr. Auditorium in honor of its former Punong Barangay who served from 1972 to 2007 and concurrently as ABC President of the Municipality of Lingayen for 19 years;

WHEREAS, it is but fitting to name said Auditorium in his honor for having faithfully and productively served Barangay Rosario and the Municipality of Lingayen for many years, thus immensely contributing to the growth and development of Barangay Rosario and the capital town of Lingayen;

WHEREAS, it is most appropriate to name the Auditorium under his name as a fitting tribute to his initiative in donating the parcel of lot to which the building now stands;

WHEREAS, prior consultation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) has been complied with to which no objection thereto was interposed, and with the required public hearing which was conducted on April 25, 2021;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SK Federation President, SBM Gabriel Ivan C. Tuazon, duly seconded by SBM Jasper S. Pasion, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass and approve this corresponding ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 101, S-2021

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED MULTI-PURPOSE HALL LOCATED IN BARANGAY ROSARIO, THIS MUNICIPALITY, AS GABRIEL D. TUAZON, SR. AUDITORIUM.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall be known as "An ordinance naming the newly constructed Multi-Purpose Hall located in Barangay Rosario, this municipality, as Gabriel D. Tuazon, Sr. Auditorium".

SECION 2. The newly constructed Multi-Purpose Hall located at Barangay Rosario is hereby named as Gabriel D. Tuazon, Sr. Auditorium.

SECTION 3. The Barangay Council of Rosario shall cause the putting-up of a visible signage to the Multi-Purpose Hall as "Gabriel D. Tuazon, Sr. Auditorium".

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan.
