ORDINANCE NO. 78, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM THROUGH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS RELATIVE THERETO.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title - The scholarship grant shall be known and cited as the "Lingayen Scholarship Program" with sub-title which shall be known and cited as "*Iskolar ako ng Bayan*;"

SECTION 2. Purpose - The purpose of establishing the scholarship program is to provide a better chance and opportunity to poor but deserving students to study and see their way through state-owned colleges and universities or even in private schools in the locality and neighboring towns offering technical, vocational or college degree courses but whose tuition fees are marginal and not far beyond from what the state-owned colleges and universities are charging.

SECTION 3. Members of the Board.

A. There shall be established a Selection Board which composition shall be as follows:

- 1) The Members of the Board shall be headed by the Municipal Mayor as Chairman;

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- 2) The MSWDO as Vice-Chairman;
- 3) Municipal Information Officer as the Secretary (as the secretary, the MIO is also in charge of giving examinations to applicants);
- 4) The Municipal Treasurer as Treasurer;
- 5) Chairman on Committee on Education and Culture and the Chairman Committee on Appropriations of the Sangguniang Bayan as member;

B. The functions of the Board shall be:

- 1) To propose to the Sanggunian annual budgetary allocations for the operation and maintenance of the scholarship program;
- 2) To exercise full supervision and control in the operation and management of the scholarship program;
- 3) To formulate policies, rules and regulations not otherwise provided hereof;
- 4) To authorize the Secretariat to send letters to private individuals for the purpose of soliciting funds for the scholarship program to be identified by all the members of the board.

SECTION 4. Secretariat.

A. There shall be a Secretariat to be composed of the following Offices:

- 1) Municipal Information Office
- 2) Office of the Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan

B. The functions of the Secretariat shall be:

- 1) To post on the website of the Local Government Unit (LGU) the text, contents or salient features of this ordinance including the account number of this particular nomenclature for the information of the prospects or would-be benefactors;
- 2) To look for and secure addresses of well-off individuals who hail from this municipality and forthwith prepare fund solicitation letters to be signed by the Chairman and/or Vice Chairman;
- 3) Perform all other related tasks that may be deemed necessary by the Chairman or by the members of the Board.

SECTION 5. Meetings and Quorum.

- A. The Members of the Board shall meet at least once in every quarter of every year or as often as may be necessary;
- B. Majority of the members of the Board present shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION 6. Funds of various sources.

- A. All funds that shall be originating from the government be it from municipal, provincial or national indorsed in the municipality, shall be held as Trust Fund in the municipal coffer;
- B. Held as Trust Fund should be deposited in any bank owned or controlled by the government which bank account shall be separate and distinct from all other accounts of the municipal government of Lingayen. Hence, the Municipal Treasurer is required to open an account for this purpose;

... beginning calendar year 2020 and onwards.

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

- C. All donations should come in the form of checks, treasury warrants, Philippine Postal money order and even in the form of cash and, should only be addressed to the "Municipality of Lingayen (Lingayen Scholarship Program)" as the named recipient or donee and which donation or donations shall, accordingly, be issued with official receipt;

SECTION 7. Bank Signatories - The Municipal Mayor as Chairman and the Municipal Treasurer as Treasurer of the Board shall be the signatories in all bank transactions. Provided, however, that there shall be no deposits or withdrawals that shall be executed by the aforesaid signatories without the prior knowledge, consent or authority from the Members of the Board.

SECTION 8. Recipient's Qualifications - The recipient of the scholarship program shall have the following qualifications:

- A. Must be a Filipino citizen, regardless of sex, civil status, religious affiliation or belief, a resident of the Municipality of Lingayen, a graduate in any of the secondary institutions in the municipality and, a person of good moral character and integrity;
- B. Must have passed the college entrance examination and prior to it was chosen from among the number of applicants in a given year by the Members of the Board through well-safeguarded examinations given for the purpose;
- C. Must be financially needy (parents' annual gross income must not exceed Php200,000.00);
- D. Must not have been the subject of any disciplinary action; and
- E. Must be in healthy condition.

SECTION 9. Number of Recipients. The number of recipients shall be determined each year by the Members of the Board depending on the fund's capability of the scholarship program.

SECTION 10. Benefits Defined. P5,000.00 per semester

SECTION 11. A sum of ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) shall be appropriated and included regularly in the General Fund under Non-Office Expenditures of the Annual Municipal Budget of the LGU beginning Calendar year 2020 and onwards.

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 13. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulation, or part thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.

RESOLUTION NO. 160-2020

DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 78, S-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM THROUGH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS RELATIVE THERETO" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 78, Series of 2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee and Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 447 (a) (5) (xi) of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, the amount of P1,000,000.00 is appropriated in the 2020 Annual Budget of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject ordinance in order;

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
