### EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Lingayen, dubbed as "The heart, the soul and the face of the Province of Pangasinan is bounded on the north by Lingayen Gulf; on the south by Bugallon, on the east by Binmaley; and on the west by Labrador;

WHEREAS, Lingayen, a community and a home of God-loving people with a shared vision, aiming to be Number One in all aspects of governance being the Capital Town of the Great Province of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Lingayen is adopting a Municipal Logo/Seal as its official seal which will serve as an inspiring symbol of unity, solidarity and teamwork of people determined to achieve prosperity with transparency and accountability for the love of its municipality;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Logo manifests the municipality's vision as a benchmark of good governance, with a self-sufficient economy powered by God-Centered and law abiding people in a tourism-oriented and ecologically-balanced environment, emanating preeminence, pride and progress;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo duly seconded by all, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enact this corresponding ordinance.

**ORDINANCE NO. 79, S-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL LOGO AS THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, PRESCRIBING THE USE AND IMPOSING PENALTY FOR UNOFFICIAL/UNAUTHORIZED USE THEREOF.**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as “AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL LOGO AS THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, PRESCRIBING THE USE AND IMPOSING PENALTY FOR UNOFFICIAL/UNAUTHORIZED USE THEREOF.”

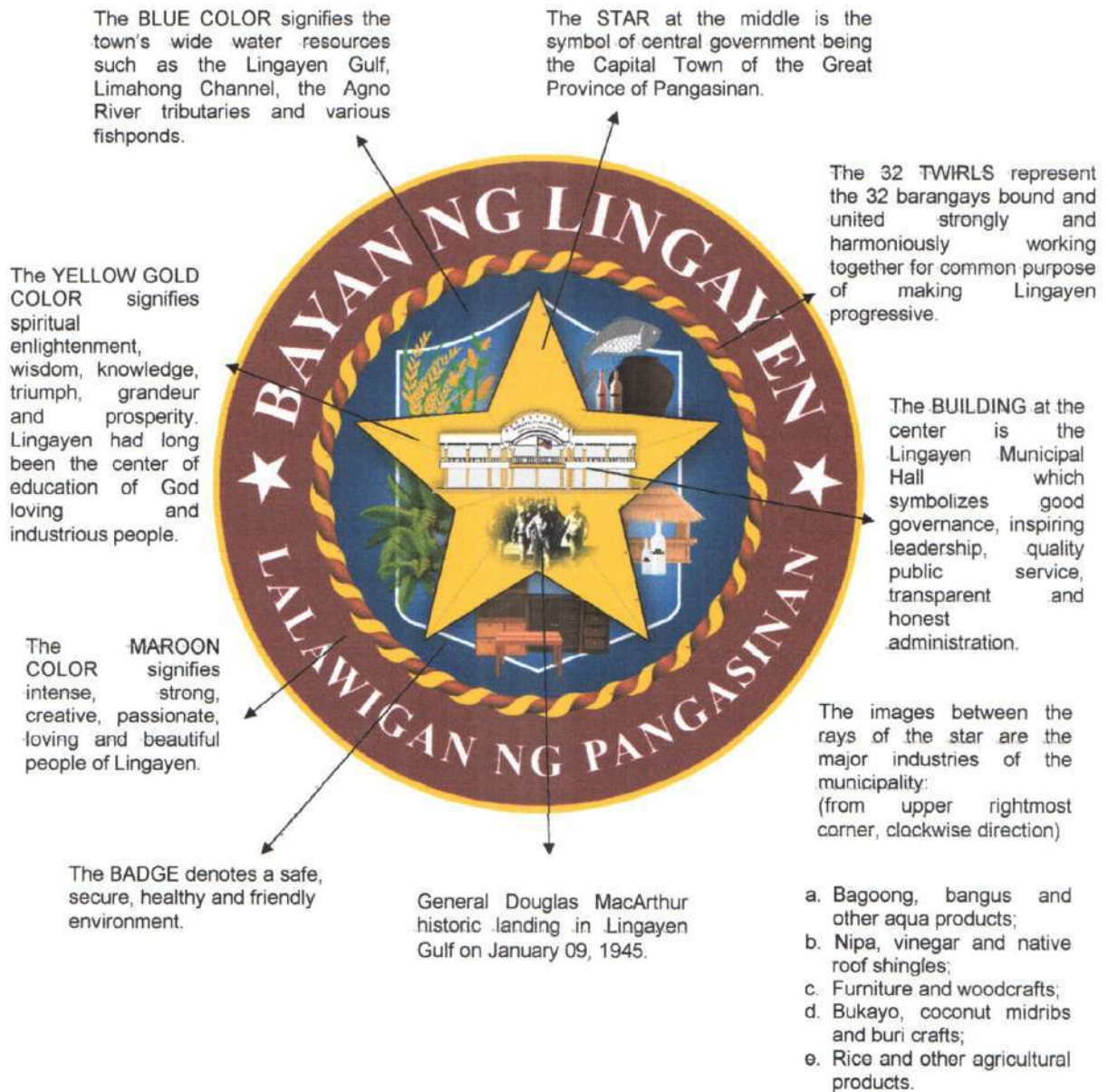
Section 2. THE MUNICIPAL LOGO AS THE OFFICIAL SEAL. The Municipal Logo in its symbols and representations, as follows:

## *Our Seal*

An inspiring symbol of unity, solidarity and teamwork of people determined to achieve prosperity with transparency and accountability for the love of its municipality.



## *Our Vision*

A benchmark of good governance, with a self-sufficient economy powered by God-centered law abiding people in a tourism-oriented and ecologically-balanced environment, emanating preeminence, pride and progress.

A. The **BUILDING** at the center is the Lingayen Municipal Hall which symbolizes good governance, *inspiring leadership, quality public service, transparent and honest administration.*

B. General Douglas MacArthur historic landing in Lingayen Gulf on January 09, 1945.

C. The **STAR** at the middle is the symbol of central government being the Capital Town of the Great Province of Pangasinan.

D. The **BLUE COLOR** signifies the town's wide water resources such as the Lingayen Gulf, Limahong Channel Agno River tributaries and various fishponds.

E. The **YELLOW GOLD COLOR** signifies spiritual enlightenment, wisdom, knowledge, triumph, grandeur and prosperity. Lingayen had long been the center of education of God loving and industrious people.

F. The **MAROON COLOR** signifies intense, strong, creative, passionate, loving and beautiful people of Lingayen.

G. The **BADGE** signifies a safe, secure, healthy and friendly environment.

H. The **32 TWIRLS** represent the 32 barangays bound and united strongly and harmoniously working together *for a common purpose of making Lingayen progressive.*

I. The **IMAGES BETWEEN THE RAYS OF THE STAR** are the major industries of the municipality (clockwise, starting from uprightmost):

- a. Bagoong, bangus and other aqua products;
- b. Nipa, vinegar and native roof shingles;
- c. Furniture and woodcrafts;
- d. Bukayo, coconut midribs and buri crafts;
- e. Rice and other agricultural products.

Section 3. **PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZED USE OF THE MUNICIPAL LOGO/SEAL.** The Municipal Logo/Seal of the Municipality of Lingayen shall be for official purposes only. It shall appear in all official documents of the municipality and in circumstances where the municipality permits the use thereof.

Section 4. **PROHIBITED ACTS.** It shall be unlawful for any person, natural or juridical without the express consent of the Municipal Mayor representing the Municipality of Lingayen, to print/use the Municipal Logo/Seal for the following purposes: sale, distribution, manufacture, publication, display or any other unauthorized acts.

Section 5. **PENAL CLAUSE.** Any violation of the provision of this Ordinance shall be meted a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) or imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days or both at the discretion of the Court.

Section 6. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** In the event any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid, the remaining provisions not affected shall remain to be effective and enforceable.

Section 7. **REPEALING CLAUSE.** Any Ordinance in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed.

Section 8. **EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.



**RESOLUTION NO. 290-2020**

**DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 79, S-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL LOGO AS THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, PRESCRIBING THE USE AND IMPOSING PENALTY FOR UNOFFICIAL/UNAUTHORIZED USE THEREOF" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 79, Series of 2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 22 (a) (3), (b) of RA 7160 and Section 2 and Chapter IV, Section 44-47 of RA No. 8491, also known as "An Act Prescribing the Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines";

**WHEREAS**, subject ordinance shall take effect after the Sangguniang Bayan has complied with the requirements of posting and publication set forth in Sections 59 and 511 of RA 7160;
