### EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, there is a Presidential Proclamation No. 922 series of 2020 issued by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to COVID-19 which enjoins all government agencies and Local Government Units to render full assistance and cooperation in this time of health crisis;

WHEREAS, the populace's movement is restricted to their homes and they can only go outside to just buy basic needs such as food, medicines and other things needed for sustenance;

WHEREAS, in order to overcome the present threat of COVID-19, the Municipality of LINGAYEN must require simultaneous efforts on different fronts, including all the persons who are living or working in the municipality, to cooperate together and work harmoniously with a common goal of defeating the COVID-19 threat;

WHEREAS, all persons are hereby enjoined to work together, among others, to protect and support our health workers and front liners, ensure that the community quarantine is strictly implemented and direct everyone to be part of the solution in reducing the local or community transmission of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the IATF, through Resolution No. 30, S-2020 dated 29 April 2020 approved and recommended the adoption of the Omnibus Guidelines for the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines, which shall apply to all regions, provinces, cities on areas placed under ECQ or GCQ;

WHEREAS, in fighting this invisible enemy, the mandatory use of face masks can significantly reduce the possibility of local or community transmission and can effectively reduce the contagion in the communities especially by persons who are asymptomatic but may already be carriers of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, by mandating the use of face masks, it will result to reduced COVID-19 infections, thus preventing health workers and hospitals from becoming overwhelmed with COVID-19 patients;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by SBM Ramon Anselmo M. Cuaresma and SBM John Silvester A. Tapia, respectively, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enact this corresponding ordinance.

**ORDINANCE NO. 80, S-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE MANDATORY USE OF FACE MASKS BY ALL PERSONS WHO ARE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN DURING THE COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND EXTENSION THEREOF.**

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the Mandatory Use of Face Mask Ordinance in the Municipality of Lingayen.

SECTION 2. Coverage. All persons who are found within the territorial jurisdiction of Municipality of Lingayen are covered by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Definition of terms:

- a. Face Masks – any reusable, disposable or improvised item made of cloth or any breathable material worn over the nose and mouth which can serve as protection or barrier against possible infection from a disease such as the COVID-19.
- b. Public places – all places, fixed or mobile, that are accessible or open to the public, or places for collective use, regardless of ownership or right to access, including but not limited to, schools, work places, government offices and facilities, establishments that provide food and drinks, accommodation, merchandise, professional services, entertainment, and other services. It also includes outdoor spaces where facilities are available for the public or where a crowd of people may gather such as, but not limited to, parks, playgrounds, sports grounds, health/hospital compounds, markets, walkways, and waiting areas.

Further, it shall also include public utility or common utility vehicles such as buses and minibuses offering free rides, shuttles and vans that ferry individuals and employees to and from their homes and places of work.

SECTION 4. Mandatory Use of Face Masks or Other Similar Paraphernalia and Equipment. Wearing of face masks, earloop masks, reusable or do-it-yourself masks, handkerchiefs, cloth face coverings or such other similar protective paraphernalia and equipment that can effectively lessen the transmission of COVID-19 in such manner as to cover both nose and mouth, shall be required at all times.



**SECTION 5. Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks.** *As part of the precautionary and safety measures against COVID-19, all persons within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Lingayen, Pangasinan are directed to wear the prescribe face masks sufficient to reduce, if not prevent, the probability of transmission and mitigate contamination from points of source during the State of Calamity due to COVID-19.*

The wearing of face masks shall always be done in all public places where a transmission of the said illness may take place through the modes of transmission as published by authorities in the field of public health.

**SECTION 6. Compliance in all Public Places and Private Commercial Establishments.** *To effectively promote and encourage compliance to this Ordinance, all public places and private commercial establishments operating in the Municipality of Lingayen shall conspicuously display at or near the entrance of the establishment a full copy of this Ordinance and a "No Mask, No Entry" sign.*

**SECTION 7. Enforcement.** *Members of the PNP, Barangay Tanods and deputized task force shall apprehend against violators of this ordinance.*

**SECTION 8. Penalty Clause**

8.1 Adults violating this Ordinance shall be fined with the following:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense - One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) Pesos
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 2,500.00) or five (5) days imprisonment or both upon determination of the court of competent jurisdiction.

8.2 For Minors who violated this Ordinance, the parent /guardian who has allowed, by will or by negligence, the minor to violate the Ordinance, shall be liable to a fine of:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense - One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) Pesos
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 2,500.00) or five (5) days imprisonment or both such fine upon determination of the court of competent jurisdiction.

**SECTION 9. Effectivity Clause.** *This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after posting in conspicuous places in the Municipality of Lingayen for the information and compliance of the public and the mandatory wearing of face mask shall continue notwithstanding the lifting of ECQ until or while the threat of COVID-19 is still persisting, subject to the issuance and/or guidelines of the proper government authority.*

**RESOLUTION NO. 500-2020**

**DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 80, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE MANDATORY USE OF FACE MASKS BY ALL PERSONS WHO ARE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, DURING THE COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND EXTENSION THEREOF" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 80, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 447 (a) (1) (iii) of RA 7160; DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-071 (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks or Other Protective Equipment in Public Places) and Provincial Ordinance No. 235-2020 (An Ordinance Requiring the Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks by all Persons in Public Places Within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Pangasinan During the Period of Enhanced Community Quarantine and For Any Extension Thereof);

**WHEREAS**, however, the Sanggunian shall consider the observations of the Provincial Legal Officer in her opinion dated May 21, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, subject ordinance shall take effect after the requirements of posting and publication pursuant to Sections 59 (c) and 511 (a) of RA 7160 are complied with by the Sangguniang Bayan;

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Ordinance No. 80, S-2020 of the Sangguniang Bayan of **Lingayen**, Pangasinan, entitled “An Ordinance requiring the mandatory use of face masks by all persons who are within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Lingayen, Pangasinan, during the Community Quarantine and extension thereof” as within the conferred powers of the Sangguniang Bayan to enact;
