EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Section 4C.01 of Municipal Ordinance No. 18, S-2014, otherwise known as the Market Code of the Municipality of Lingayen, Province of Pangasinan, imposes a twenty-five percent (25%) surcharge on rentals for market stalls and spaces in the market premises not paid on time;

WHEREAS, most market vendors have unpaid rentals going back several years, and a 25% surcharge was imposed on these rentals;

WHEREAS, the need to enhance revenue administration and collection as far as the public market is concerned should be undertaken with humanitarian consideration towards the market vendors;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo duly seconded by SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem and SBM Ramon Anselmo M. Cuaresma respectively, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass this corresponding ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 85, S-2020

AN ORDINANCE ENHANCING REVENUE ADMINISTRATION AND COLLECTION BY GRANTING AN AMNESTY ON ALL UNPAID SURCHARGES IMPOSED BY THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2019, WITH RESPECT TO RENTALS FOR MARKET STALLS AND SPACES IN THE MARKET PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Short Title - This ordinance shall be known as the "Surcharge Amnesty Ordinance of 2020".

SECTION 2. Coverage - There is hereby authorized and granted an amnesty on the 25% surcharge, hereinafter called Surcharge Amnesty, which shall cover the surcharge on unpaid rentals for market stalls and spaces, with or without assessments duly issued therefor, which have remained unpaid or have accrued as of June 30, 2019.

SECTION 3. Entitlement Under Surcharge Amnesty – The concerned market vendor may enjoy the immunities and privileges of the Surcharge Amnesty by paying all remaining and unpaid rentals for market stalls and spaces as of June 30, 2019, plus interest of two percent (2%) per month, as provided for in Section 4C.01 of the Market Code of the Municipality of Lingayen.

SECTION 4. Availment of the Surcharge Amnesty; When and Where to File and Pay – The market vendor concerned shall, within two (2) years from the effectivity of this Ordinance, pay in full the unpaid rental and interest accruing as of June 30, 2019, to the Treasurer's Office of Lingayen, Pangasinan.

SECTION 5. Certificate of Availment – Upon full payment of the unpaid rental and interest accruing as of June 30, 2019, the Municipal Treasurer shall issue to the market vendor a Certificate of Availment of the Surcharge Amnesty Ordinance of 2020 of availment.

SECTION 6. Immunities and Privileges – Market vendors covered by the Surcharge Amnesty, which have fully complied with all the conditions set forth in this Ordinance, including the payment of the rental and interest accruing as of June 30, 2019, shall be immune from the payment of all surcharges arising from the failure to pay any and all rental accruing as of June 30, 2019, and from all appurtenant civil, criminal, and administrative cases and penalties.

SECTION 7. Reportorial Requirements – The Municipal Treasurer shall submit to the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen and the Office of the Mayor a detailed report on the implementation of this Ordinance within six (6) months after the two (2)-year period of availment of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause – All other ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
