EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XV, Section 4 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, it is the duty of the family to take care of its elderly members while the State may design programs of social security for them;

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2016, R.A. No. 10868 which is "An Act Honoring and Granting Additional Benefits and Privileges to Filipino Centenarians, and for other Purposes" or otherwise known as the "Centenarian Act of 2016" was signed into law;

WHEREAS, the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 10868 was approved and adopted on September 26, 2016 wherein it was stated that aside from the benefits and privileges given by the National Government, all Local Government Units are mandated to accord awards and incentives to Filipino Centenarians who are residents in their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, pursuant also to R.A. No. 9994, Section 2 (d), the Municipality of Lingayen encourages its families and communities they live with to reaffirm the valued Filipino tradition of caring for the senior citizens;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Lingayen recognizes the integral role of Senior Citizens to nation-building, endows benefits and privileges to Senior Citizens pursuant to RA 9994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010;

WHEREAS, with the modern lifestyle and ways of many Filipinos, maintaining a healthy and active life has become a challenge, hence, reaching a decade is an extraordinary feat;

WHEREAS, every individual's pursuit of living up to 80-100 years demand rigid persistence and self-discipline, citing studies which showed that while genetics play a role in longevity, the dominant factor in living long is one's lifestyle;

WHEREAS, Octogenarians, Nonagenarians, and Centenarians are deemed as epitome of aging well and healthy living, thus, proper recognition and rewards are conferred to them considering that they are living links of society;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Ramon Anselmo M. Cuaresma seconded by SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo and SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to enact this corresponding ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 90, S-2020

AN ORDINANCE HONORING AND GRANTING CASH INCENTIVES TO OCTOGENARIANS, NONAGENARIANS, AND CENTENARIANS, IN THIS MUNICIPALITY.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. **Short Title** - This Ordinance shall be known as "The Cash Incentives for Octogenarians, Nonagenarians, and Centenarians in the Municipality of Lingayen".

SECTION 2. **Definition of Terms** – As used in this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- a. Octogenarian – a person who is between 80 and 89 years old.
- b. Nonagenarian – a person who is between 90 and 99 years old.
- c. Centenarian – a person who is a hundred or more years old.
- d. Letter of Felicitation – a letter from the Municipality of Lingayen acknowledging or congratulating the Octogenarian, Nonagenarian, and Centenarian on his/her longevity;
- e. Plaque of Recognition – an award given to Octogenarians, Nonagenarians, and Centenarians by the Municipality of Lingayen.

SECTION 3. **Cash Incentive and Felicitation Letter** - Upon reaching Eightieth (80th), Ninetieth (90th), and One Hundredth (100th) birthday, every senior citizen resident of Lingayen shall be honored with:

a) Letter of Felicitation from the Local Government Unit of Lingayen acknowledging his/her longevity;

b) A Cash Incentive of P500.00 for Octogenarians, P1,000.00 for Nonagenarians, and P10,000 for Centenarians; *and*

c) A Certificate of Recognition.

SECTION 4. **Respect for Centenarians Day** - All living centenarians who reached their One Hundredth (100th) birthday prior to the effectivity of this Ordinance shall be honored on the Elderly Week Celebration. They shall be awarded a Certificate of Recognition and the Cash Incentive referred to in Section 3 hereof. In the same

event, posthumous Certificates of Recognition in honor of deceased centenarians shall be presented to the nearest surviving relative of each centenarian or his/her representative.

SECTION 5. **Funding** - During the initial year of the implementation of this Ordinance, the requisite fund shall be sourced from the Special Purpose Appropriation Funds of the Local Government Unit. It may be charged to the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare Fund. Subsequently, the amount of P1,000,000.00 to implement the provisions of this Ordinance shall be included in the succeeding Annual Budgets.

SECTION 6. **Centenarians Committee** - The following shall constitute the committee:

Chairperson: Local Chief Executive

Co-Chairperson: OSCA (Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs) Head

Members:

1. MSWDO (Municipal Social Welfare & Development Officer)
2. Senior Citizens Federation President
3. Local Civil Registrar
4. ABC President
5. Local Finance Committee
6. Sangguniang Bayan Committee Chairperson on the Elderly

SECTION 7. **Eligibility Requirements.**

1. Certificate of Birth duly certified by the Local Civil Registrar where the awardee was born and/or by the Philippine Statistics Office (PSA);
2. Valid Identification (any Government issued ID);
3. He/She must be a natural born resident of Lingayen and must have resided in Lingayen in at least more than half of his/her life;
4. He/She must be a holder of a Lingayen Senior Citizen Identification Card issued by the OSCA.

In the absence of a Certificate of Birth, prospective beneficiaries must submit other supporting documents such as, but not limited to the following:

1. Marriage Contract;
2. Baptism and/or Confirmation certificates;
3. Birth Certificates of child/children.

The aforementioned requirements shall be submitted for assessment and verification to the Centenarians Committee.


SECTION 8. **Repealing Clause** - All previous issuances, ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. **Separability Clause** - If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. **Effectivity** - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation within the Municipality of Lingayen.



DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 90, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE HONORING AND GRANTING CASH INCENTIVES TO OCTOGENARIANS, NONAGENARIANS, AND CENTENARIANS IN THIS MUNICIPALITY" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 90, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Sections 17 (b) (2) (iv) and 447 (a) (1), (5) (xiv) of RA 7160; Republic Act No. 10868, otherwise known as "An Act Honoring and Granting Additional Benefits and Privileges to Filipino Centenarians, and For Other Purposes"; and Article XV, Section 4 of the Philippine Constitution;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject ordinance in order;
