### EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of its people;

WHEREAS, Section 6 (e) of Republic Act 11332 provides that Local Government Units have the authority to conduct and enforce disease surveillance and response systems, epidemic/outbreak and epidemiologic investigations, and rapid containment, quarantine and isolation, disease prevention and control measures;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen enacted Ordinance No. 80, S-2020 which required the mandatory use of face masks by all persons who are within the territorial jurisdiction of Lingayen, Pangasinan during the community quarantine and extension thereof, on May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-14, dated August 3, 2020, mandating that all officials/heads of various transportation sectors to enjoin, within their respective jurisdictions, the mandatory wearing of face shields (aside from face masks) for all passengers in areas where public transportation is allowed effective August 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, studies show that face shields further reduce viral exposure and in order to promote a more comprehensive action to curb the spread of COVID-19, the Local Government of Lingayen, following the lead of the DTI-DOLE and DOTr, deems it necessary to impose the wearing of face shields along with face masks by all persons in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of Lingayen;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by SBM Ramon Anselmo M. Cuaresma, be it:

**ORDINANCE NO. 93, S-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF FACE SHIELDS WHILE INSIDE WORKPLACE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, AND IN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.**

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan in session duly assembled that:

Section 1. *SHORT TITLE.* This ordinance shall be known as the "***Mandatory Wearing of Face Shields Ordinance***".

Section 2. *PERSONS LIABLE.* All persons in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of Lingayen, Pangasinan are required to wear face shields along with face masks all the time. Otherwise they shall be charged for violation of this ordinance.

Section 3. *DEFINITIONS.* For purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions shall mean as follows:

- a) *Face Shield* - a personal protective equipment device typically made of clear plastic that protects the facial area which can serve as protection or barrier against possible infection from COVID-19.
- b) *Public Place* - refers to any place located in the Municipality of Lingayen where people in general may access, including but not limited to streets, highways, sidewalks, parking lots, transportation terminals, public vacant lots, parks, plazas, bay walks, sari-sari stores, supermarkets, public and wet markets, pharmacies, drugstores, banks, offices, and the common areas in and about pawnshops, money changers, remittance centers, churches, residential buildings, malls, shopping centers, commercial establishments, entertainment places, public and private office buildings, hospitals, clinics, barangay centers, and schools.

Section 4. *ROLE OF COMMERCIAL AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS.* All commercial and business establishments in the Municipality of Lingayen are hereby encouraged to take appropriate measures that all employees and persons going to and from, or otherwise found in their respective establishments shall observe the mandatory use of face shield.

Section 5. *ENFORCEMENT.* This ordinance shall be implemented by the Punong Barangays and their Barangay Tanods, the Lingayen PNP, and the Municipal POSO Personnel.

Section 6. *PENALTIES.* Any person found violating this ordinance shall be meted the following penalties:

- a) First Offense – Five Hundred Pesos and/or attendance to COVID-19 awareness and prevention seminar
- b) Second Offense - One Thousand Pesos
- c) Third Offense - One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos



- d) Subsequent Offenses-One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos or an imprisonment of one (1) week or both at the discretion of the court

Section 7. *NO CONTEST PROVISION.* Any person caught in violation of this Ordinance who does not wish to contest the violation and is willing to voluntarily pay the penalty imposed upon him/her prior to the filing of a formal complaint shall be allowed to pay said fine to the Municipal Treasurer's Office to avoid getting prosecuted.


Section 8. *SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.* If any section or part of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other sections or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 9. *REPEALING CLAUSE.* All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 10. *EFFECTIVITY.* This ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and shall continue to be enforced until the lifting of the State of Public Emergency due to COVID-19.

**DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 93, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF FACE SHIELDS WHILE INSIDE WORKPLACE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, AND IN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 93, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Sections 16 and 447 (a) (1), (5) (xii) of RA 7160; DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-071 Re: Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks or Other Preventive Equipment in Public Places and Memorandum Circular No. 2020-014 of the Department of Transportation;

**WHEREAS**, subject ordinance shall take effect after the requirement of publication pursuant to Section 511 (a) of RA 7160 has been complied with;
