### RESOLUTION NO. 100, S-2019

#### AUTHORIZING HON. MAYOR LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO RE-OPEN, OPERATE AND DEVELOP THE COMMON TERMINAL AND THE LOT WHERE IT IS SITUATED.

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2019, the Common Terminal located along Solis St., Lingayen, Pangasinan, was CLOSED for failure of the Lessee, Remsien Trading and Construction, to pay the required business permit;

WHEREAS, upon closure, the LGU of Lingayen effectively took exclusive possession of the Common Terminal, its business stalls, as well as the entire lot where it is situated, particularly Lot 60176-part, containing an area of 6,495 square meters;

WHEREAS, the closure displaced public utility vehicles and businesses who were using the Common Terminal prior to its closure;

WHEREAS, it is more beneficial to the people of Lingayen to re-open and develop the Common Terminal, its business stalls, and the lot where it is situated;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem duly seconded by all, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED;

1) To authorize Hon. Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil to re-open, operate and develop the Common Terminal, its business stalls, as well as the lot where it is situated in accordance with existing laws and ordinances.

2) To collect fees, rental, and other charges from third persons, natural or juridical, for the use of the common terminal, its business stalls, and the lot where it is situated.
