RESOLUTION NO. 205, S-2020

REQUIRING ALL PRIVATELY-OWNED BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN TO POST HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS AGAINST COVID-19 IN CONSPICUOUS PLACES WITHIN THEIR BUILDINGS OR BUSINESS AREAS AND ESTABLISH A QUEUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM TO ENFORCE SOCIAL DISTANCING, PREVENT TRANSMISSION AND ENSURE THAT DOH MITIGATION OBJECTIVES ARE ACHIEVED.

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 is a health catastrophe that has reached pandemic proportions and has become a concern of several countries including the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Lingayen has not been spared from this crisis;

WHEREAS, with health preventive measures implemented to the fullest extent, the Municipality has been considered a low-risk locality, hence is now under the General Community Quarantine from being under an Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, to further ensure that efforts and initiatives will not prove futile, the Municipality is not complacent in devising schemes to sustain if not further improve the current scenario by encouraging all sectors, public and private to cooperate and participate in this endeavor;

WHEREAS, the private sector can contribute to enhance public awareness on the prevention of Covid-19 by posting health and safety protocols in private business establishments which include but not limited to the following mandatory rules, to wit:

1. Frequent handwashing at least 20 seconds with soap and water
2. Wearing of Face masks
3. Physical/Social distancing of 1 to 2 meters
4. Use of alcohol and hand sanitizers
5. Frequent disinfection of the workstation

WHEREAS, a Queue Management System should be established for customers to quantify their demand service from the business facility, controlling the number being served and waiting to be served to effectively enforce physical distancing/social distancing;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem duly seconded by SBM Randall Q. Bernal, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to require all privately-owned business establishments in the Municipality of Lingayen to post health and safety protocols against COVID-19 in conspicuous places within their buildings or business areas and establish a queue management system to enforce social distancing, prevent transmission and ensure that DOH mitigation objectives are achieved.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the owners/proprietors of privately-owned business establishments for their information and guidance.
