RESOLUTION NO. 318, S-2020

GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ALL JOB ORDER AND CONTRACT OF SERVICE WORKERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN.

WHEREAS, Section 447 (a) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Bayan has the power to determine the positions and salaries including allowances and other emoluments and benefits of the employees of the Municipal Government;

WHEREAS, Joint Circular No. 1, S-2017 of COA, CSC and DBM allows government agencies including LGUs to hire Job Order and Contract of Service Workers to undertake special projects for the municipality and to augment the work force on a certain period of time;

WHEREAS, Job Order and Contract of Service Workers are not covered by Civil Service law and rules and do not have benefits enjoyed by government employees such as leave, PERA, RATA and 13th month pay;

WHEREAS, despite the fact that their jobs are temporary and intermittent, the municipal government recognizes their efforts, contributions and hard work in helping the LGU thrive especially in this time of pandemic;

WHEREAS, with the imposition of community quarantine in the country, alternative work arrangements were imposed in government agencies, LGU Lingayen in particular, adopted the skeleton workforce which meant lesser working days for the "no work, no pay" Job Order and Contract of Service workers;

WHEREAS, the brunt of the pandemic was deeply felt by the Municipal Job Orders and Contract of Service considering that they are not entitled to salary or wages. To help them defray for the basic necessities and medical needs of their families, the Municipal Government find it meritorious to extend a financial assistance of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) to help them overcome the challenges under the community quarantine and to reward them for their faithful service to the LGU;

WHEREAS, the amount to be extended shall be taken from any available source from the General Fund to be determined by the Local Finance Committee;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by all members present, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to grant financial assistance to all Job Order and Contract of Service Workers of the Municipality of Lingayen, Pangasinan.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Municipal Mayor, HRMO, and Local Finance Committee for their information and guidance.

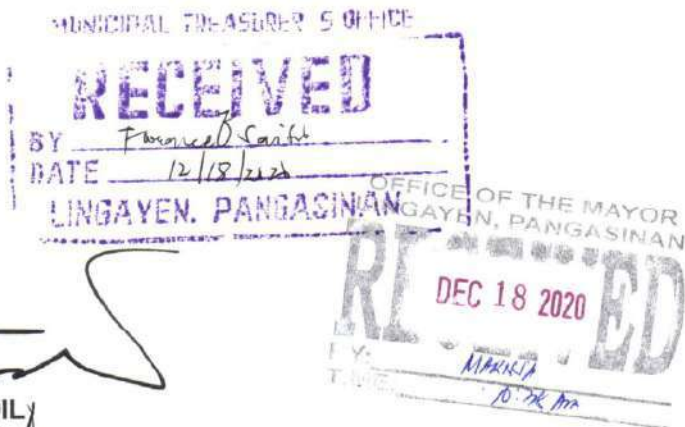

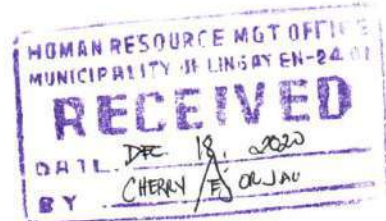
