RESOLUTION NO. 383, S-2021

AUTHORIZING HON. MAYOR LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO FILE A REQUEST/APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION / RESERVATION OF A TEN (10) HECTARE AREA OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED IN PANGAPISAN NORTH, LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF A LINGAYEN ECO-TOURISM, FOREST PARK AND GOVERNMENT CAMPSITE UNDER THE DIRECT CONTROL, MANAGEMENT, AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN.

WHEREAS, with over 7,000 islands, the natural resource base of the country for ecotourism consists of a diverse array of wetland, mountains, volcanoes, rugged cliffs, seascapes, coasts, beaches, lakes, forests, caves, fields and a rich variety of plants and animals. As a mega-diversity country, the Philippines offers one of the best destinations for ecotourism in Asia and the ASEAN region;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the country's prioritization of tourism as a major development program, the thrusts of the government for infrastructure, business, trade, and services have been aligned towards providing basic requirements for expansion of tourism. The current infrastructure, services, and human resource opportunities in the tourism sector (i.e. existing and in the pipeline), particularly for ecotourism, include provision of transportation networks, tourism services, and human resources;

WHEREAS, a ten (10) hectare area of the public domain situated in Pangapisan North, Lingayen, Pangasinan, is a prime location for the establishment of an eco-tourism, forest park and government campsite in the Municipality of Lingayen;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by SBM Jasper S. Pasion, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to authorize Hon. Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil to:

1. File a request/application on behalf of the Local Government Unit of Lingayen, Pangasinan, for the Presidential Proclamation/Reservation of a ten (10) hectare area of the public domain situated in Pangapisan North, Lingayen, Pangasinan, for the purpose of a Lingayen Eco-Tourism, Forest Pak, and Government Campsite, which parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land as shown on the Plan, situated in Barangay Pangapisan North, Municipality of Lingayen, Province of Pangasinan, Island of Luzon, bounded on the SE, along lines 1-2-3 by an unclassified public land; on the SW, along lines 3-4-5-6-7 by (existing Bay walk 20.00 meter wide), unclassified public land and Agno River, on the NW, along lines 7-8-9-10-11-12-13-14-15-16-17 by (existing Bay walk 20.00 meter wide) and Limahong Channel, and on the NE, along lines 17-18-19-20-21-22-23-24-25-26-27-28-29-30-1 by (existing Bay walk 20.00 meter wide), 50.00 meter wide salvage zone and Lingayen Gulf Beginning at point marked "I" of the said plan being N.76 deg.03'W, 3535.47 M, from PNG-67, Lingayen Cadastre

2. Process the approval by concerned authorities of the survey of the land to be reserved;
3. Cause the preparation, file, submit, and receive all documents necessary for the request/application for Presidential Proclamation/Reservation;
4. Sign all deeds, documents, and instruments necessary for the foregoing purpose.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and all other concerned agencies for their information and appropriate action.
