WHEREAS, Commissioner Sandra Sanchez-Montano has proven herself to be an effective exponent of women's agenda by developing numerous plans and programs on Gender Equality and Women Empowerment geared towards productivity where women are independent, self-reliant and contributory partners in development and nation-building;
