RESOLUTION NO. 507, S-2021

REQUESTING MAYOR LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO ALLOW A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) PASSENGERS PER TRICYCLE PROVIDED THEY CAN SHOW PROOF THAT THEY ARE FAMILY MEMBERS LIVING IN ONE (1) ROOF.

WHEREAS, because of the declaration of Public Health Emergency due to COVID-19, the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) have set transportation protocols and guidelines to ensure the safety of the riding public in addition to the strict implementation of social distancing measures in areas under General Community Quarantine status;

WHEREAS, as per the new protocol, the capacity and passenger load for tricycle must not exceed one passenger in the sidecar while back riding is not allowed to adhere to the physical distancing rule;

WHEREAS, the one passenger limit on tricycles have adversely affected the income of tricycle drivers and operators;

WHEREAS, there has been a clamor from the different Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association especially the riding public in Lingayen to ease the restriction on passenger capacity for tricycles and to allow family members to ride together (one at the side car and one at the back) for as long as they can show proof that they live in one roof, to help them get out from the snare of poverty;

WHEREAS, the residents are having a hard time in public transportation and the costly fare of one (1) person per tricycle is a burden to them;

WHEREAS, the tricycle drivers and operators are determined to abide to all health and safety protocols and to put up a plastic barrier between the driver and back passenger to serve as a protective shield;

WHEREAS, this measure can help tricycle drivers to earn more and the riding public especially family members to lessen transport fee, provide enough for their family's needs, and ease the emotional and psychological strain the pandemic has been causing them;

WHEREFORE, on motion of VM Judy DL. Vargas-Quiocho, duly seconded by SBMs Mac Dexter G. Malicdem and Jasper S. Pasion, be it:

RESOLVD AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil to allow a maximum of two (2) passengers per tricycle provided they can show proof that they are family members living in one (1) roof.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Honorable Leopoldo N. Bataoil for his information and appropriate action.
