RESOLUTION NO. 508, S-2021

EXPRESSING APPRECIATION AND PROFOUND GRATITUDE TO SECRETARY SILVESTRE H. BELLO III OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE), FOR HIS UNWAVERING SUPPORT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF LINGAYEN IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DOLE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to uphold the constitutional rights to life and property, and to provide maximum care, assistance and services to individuals and families affected by disaster, implement emergency rehabilitation projects to lessen the impact of disaster, and facilitate resumption of normal social and economic activities;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) has been mandated to implement social protection programs, projects, and services to mitigate the effects of the declaration of public health emergency on the economic, physical and psycho-social well-being of the vulnerable sectors;

WHEREAS, Section 4 (f) (2) of RA 11494 or the Bayanihan to Recover as One Act mandates the provision of assistance to displaced workers in the informal sector, regardless of type of employment, due to the COVID-19 pandemic;

rehabilitation measures of the national government to cushion the impact of the pandemic to the economy and society;

WHEREAS, many disadvantaged and displaced workers from Lingayen including those affected by reduction of workdays or work hours who have no means of generating income during the pandemic have availed of the assistance and socio-economic relief. They were tapped to do community projects such as eco-tourism, repair and/or improvement of common public facilities, de-clogging of canals, debris clearing, basic repair of public infrastructure, repair and/or rehabilitation of farm-to-market roads and similar facilities, tree planting, seedling preparation, and other similar activities;

WHEREAS, the emergency employment provided immediate relief to the affected vulnerable sectors of the community and helped ease their financial burdens;

WHEREAS, the continuous support being extended to the Local Government Unit of Lingayen by DOLE has enabled the municipality to mitigate the impact of unemployment and poverty in the municipality as a result of the imposition of quarantine measures;

WHEREFORE, on motion of VM Judy DL. Vargas-Quiocho, duly seconded by SBM Jonathan Carl R. Arcinue, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to express appreciation and profound gratitude to Honorable Silvestre H. Bello III, Secretary of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) for his unwavering support to the Local Government Unit of Lingayen in the implementation of DOLE programs and services.
