



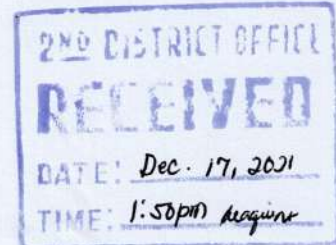

RESOLUTION NO. 548, S-2021

REQUESTING HON. JUMEL ANTHONY I. ESPINO, CONGRESSMAN, SECOND DISTRICT OF PANGASINAN, FOR FIFTEEN MILLION PESOS (P15,000,000.00) FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW LINGAYEN LEGISLATIVE BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) is the local legislative branch of the municipal government responsible for the enactment of ordinances and resolutions for the effective and efficient administration of the municipality;

WHEREAS, currently, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen is housed at the second floor of the Lingayen Municipal Hall alongside other executive offices in a relatively modest office space;

WHEREAS, due to the growing number of personnel and clientele, there is a need for bigger offices for the Sangguniang Bayan Members and staff and a more spacious and conducive Plenary Hall to accommodate greater number of people including resource speakers and visiting Barangay Officials with legislative concerns;

WHEREAS, the new Legislative Building shall house the Vice Mayor's Office, Councilors' Office, Sangguniang Bayan Secretariat, Session Hall, Association of Barangay Captains and Sangguniang Kabataan Hall, and the Municipal Public Library;

WHEREAS, the transfer of the SB to the new proposed site is in compliance to the law on separation of powers and the checks and balances between the executive and legislative branches;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Lingayen has insufficient fund to undertake the project much as it wants to, but knowing of the kindness

and benevolence of the Second District Congressman, it is hopeful that the project will materialize with his initiative and active support;

WHEREAS, the realization of the project shall serve as a precious gift by the good Congressman not only to the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen and its employees but to the entire populace of Lingayen who will be benefitted with better law enactments and legislative services;


WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by all members present, be it:
