**RESOLUTION NO. 023, S-2022**

**REQUESTING VICE PRESIDENT AND EDUCATION SECRETARY SARA DUTERTE-CARPIO TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR NEW CLASSROOMS AND SCHOOL BUILDINGS AT DORONGAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BARANGAY DORONGAN, THIS MUNICIPALITY.**

WHEREAS, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights recognizes education as a fundamental right necessary for the growth of an individual and the development of society;

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XV, of the 1987 Constitution of the Philippines provides that the "State shall promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels of education and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all";

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the same Article also states that the "State shall establish and maintain a system of free public education in the elementary and high school levels";

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9155, otherwise known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, requires the State to protect and promote the right of all Filipinos to quality and accessible education by providing free and compulsory education in the elementary level and free education in the high school level;

WHEREAS, one of the priority thrusts of the Municipal Government of Lingayen is to give quality education to its constituents especially to the youth and underprivileged;

WHEREAS, Barangay Dorongan, Lingayen where Dorongan Elementary School is situated, is a flood prone and erosion prone area; as a consequence, parents and pupils of the said elementary school opted to transfer to nearby schools leaving the said elementary school dormant for several years now;

WHEREAS, the flooding and soil erosion on the area has long been contained by providing engineering solutions through the initiative of the local and national governments;

WHEREAS, at present, Barangay Dorongan is one of three (3) barangays in the municipality with no functioning Elementary School and the Municipal Government and DepEd officials of Pangasinan I are desirous to activate the existing school pursuant to the objectives of Republic Act No. 9155;

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need for additional school buildings and classrooms to complement the existing structures at Dorongan Elementary School before reactivating its operation;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by SBM Jonathan T. Ramos, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request Vice President and Education Secretary Sara Duterte-Carpio to allocate funds for new classrooms and school buildings at Dorongan Elementary School, Barangay Dorongan, Lingayen, Pangasinan.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to all offices concerned for their information and appropriate action.
