RESOLUTION NO. 586, S-2022

EXTENDING THE PAYMENT AND RENEWAL OF THE MAYOR'S PERMIT FOR TRICYCLES AND PEDICABS FROM FEBRUARY 15, 2022 TO FEBRUARY 28, 2022 WITHOUT PENALTIES OR SURCHARGES.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan is in receipt of a letter from the Local Chief Executive endorsing to the August Body the appeal of the Lingayen Federated Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association requesting for extension of the deadline for payment of Permit to Operate;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Ordinance No. 25, S-2014, otherwise known as the Lingayen Tricycle and Pedicab Ordinance of 2014, specifically states that the last day for renewal of accreditation of TODAs and PODAs shall be on or before February 15 every year;

WHEREAS, Section 167 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "unless otherwise provided, all local taxes, fees, and charges shall be paid within the first twenty days of January or of each sub-sequent quarter, as the case may be. The sanggunian concerned may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time for payment of such taxes, fees or charges without surcharges or penalties, but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months";

WHEREAS, due to the effects of the pandemic in the transportation sector, drivers of tricycles and pedicabs struggled to make a living and has to battle daily the high cost of gasoline, smaller number of passengers, higher fare, limited passenger capacity, and government-imposed curfew hours which resulted to a huge dip in their earnings;

WHEREAS, the extension of days for payment of such permit shall enable the tricycle and pedicab operators and drivers to save enough money for the renewal of their annual permits and encourage them further to adhere to social distancing protocol set by the government;


WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Jay Mark Kevin D. Crisostomo, duly seconded by all members present, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to extend the payment and renewal of the Mayor's Permit for tricycles and pedicabs from February 15, 2022 to February 28, 2022 without penalties or surcharges.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Municipal Mayor, Municipal Treasurer, and Licensing Officer for their information and guidance.




