RESOLUTION NO. 627, S-2022

REQUESTING HONORABLE MAYOR LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO GRANT ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) ANNUALLY, AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ALL BARANGAY TANODS IN THE 32 BARANGAYS OF LINGAYEN FOR SERVICES RENDERED.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, Section 4558 (a) mandates that the Local Government Units shall enact ordinances and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality pursuant to Section 16 of the Code;

WHEREAS, Chapter 4, Section 391, No. 16, of the Local Government Code, mandates the Sangguniang Barangay, as the legislative body of the barangay, to provide for the organization of community brigade, barangay tanod or community service unit as may be necessary;

WHEREAS, Chapter 4, Section 393 (d) further provides that all duly appointed members of the barangay tanod brigades or their equivalent, which number shall not be more than twenty (20) in each barangay, shall be granted insurance or other benefits during their incumbency, chargeable to the barangay or the city, or the municipal government to which the barangay belongs;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Tanod brigade plays an important role in the development and progress of the barangay. It is one of the implementing mechanisms of the Barangay Peace and Order Committee (BPOC), which has the primary task of ensuring that peace and order prevail in the barangay;

WHEREAS, under the supervision of the Punong Barangay, the barangay tanods shall:

- (a) Assist the barangay officials in the prevention of crime and the promotion of public safety;
- (b) Conduct patrollronda in the barangay;

(c) Report to the concerned barangay officials or through Hotline "117" the occurrence of any crime, fire, accident, public disturbance, environmental degradation activities, and other untoward incidents in the barangay;

(d) Monitor the presence and/or activities of suspicious persons, criminals, and other lawless elements within their jurisdiction and report the same to the proper authorities or through Hotline "117";

(e) Conduct surveillance on crime breeding areas within the barangay/*purok* and report their observations/findings to the proper authorities or through Hotline "117";

(f) Assist the police and the *lupong tagapamayapa* in the execution of warrants and other judicial processes such as tracking the whereabouts of missing persons in arresting escaped prisoners and other fugitives from justice, and in the recovery of stolen properties;

(g) Coordinate closely with the barangay officials and police/ local authorities in the drive against all forms of crimes such as terrorism, smuggling, car-napping, drug trafficking, drug pushing, illegal gambling, child abuse, crime against women, all forms of vices, and syndicated crimes;

(h) Assist in the institutionalization of PATROL "117" Programs;

(i) Assist in the implementation of the Fire Code of the Philippines;

(j) Detect all forms of fire hazards and other public safety hazards/violations and institute corrective measures with their capability;

(k) Assist in facilitating smooth flow of traffic; and

(l) Perform other functions as may be directed by the Punong Barangays.

WHEREAS, considering the difficulty and hazards of their job as order and peacemakers in the community, the hardworking Barangay Tanods of Lingayen need more to meet the demands of their work;

WHEREAS, the grant of annual financial assistance to Barangay Tanods will encourage them to efficiently and effectively perform their duties and responsibilities in their respective communities;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem and SBM Darwin B. Jimenez, duly seconded by SBM Ricardo R. Ferrer be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request to the Honorable Mayor Leopoldo N. Bataoil to grant One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00) annually as financial assistance to all Barangay Tanods in the 32 Barangays of Lingayen for services rendered.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Municipal Mayor for his favorable action.


