**RESOLUTION NO. 660, S-2022**

**AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HONORABLE LEOPOLDO N. BATAOIL TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CENTER FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT-I (DOH-CHD-I), REPRESENTED BY ITS DIRECTOR IV, PAULA PAZ M. SYDIONGCO, MD, MPH, MBA, CESO IV, RELATIVE TO THE GRANT OF ONE COVID-19 ALLOWANCE (OCA) TO ELIGIBLE HEALTH AND NON-HEALTH CARE WORKERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN.**

WHEREAS, the General Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2022, provides the basis for funds release on the grant of COVID-19 benefits for public and private health care workers and non-healthcare workers, regardless of employment status, who are involved in COVID-19 response in all health facilities including military hospitals, Government-owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), state university hospitals and private licensed health facilities;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the GAA specifically provides for the allocation of fund for COVID-19 benefits that shall be based on risk exposure of the health care worker and non-health workers in a particular setting;

WHEREAS, relative to said benefit, the Department of Health issued Administrative Order No. 2022-0001 dated January 14, 2022, prescribing the Guidelines for COVID-19 Exposure Classification for Health Care Workers, to set the parameters for determining the risk exposure of personnel in COVID-19 response-involved health facilities;

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and DOH issued Joint Circular No. 2022-0001 dated February 10, 2022, providing the guidelines for the grant of ONE COVID-19 Allowance (OCA) for public and



private health care workers and non-health care workers, particularly requiring the parties to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 444 (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Mayor shall represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Bayan or pursuant to law or ordinance;


WHEREFORE, on motion of SBM Mac Dexter G. Malicdem, duly seconded by SBM Ricardo R. Ferrer, be it:

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to authorize the Municipal Mayor, Honorable Leopoldo N. Bataoil to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Health Center for Health Development-I (DOH-CHD-I), represented by its Director IV, Paula Paz M. Sydiongco, MD, MPH, MBA, CESO IV, relative to the grant of One Covid-19 Allowance (OCA) to eligible health and non-health care workers in the Municipality of Lingayen, Province of Pangasinan.
